# BOARD POSITION DESCRIPTIONS:

PRESIDENT - Helps guide debate on the Board and membership motions. Serves as the decision maker and should be ready to face opposition, if it arises. A great opportunity for leadership experience. With a strong Board, this job will be accomplished smoothly!

VICE PRESIDENT - Will work with the "Operations" side and oversees socials and activities.

SECOND VICE PRESIDENT - Works with the "Charitable" side and oversees our charitable giving and Thrift Shop.

SECRETARY - Writes meeting minutes and keep our board reports organized. The board meetings are your main focus.

TREASURER - Takes care of both business & operations and handles our fundraising checks and out-going charitable donations. Works closely with the Thrift Shop and Charitable Chairs.

PARLIAMENTARIAN - Knows our constitution and by-laws— and helps us stay on track with our mission during board meetings. Chairs committees for the election and by-laws/constitution review.
