THRIFT SHOP HAPPENINGS

Thrift Shop/Airman's Attic is CLOSED.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the Thrift Shop was not able to re-open on January 8, 2020. Our goal is to re-open in late February/early March, but at the time of writing this article, we do not have a proposed re-opening date.

One of the reasons for our delayed re-opening is the carpeting in our new location (old bowling alley next to the refill pharmacy). There are large folds and wrinkles in the carpeting that create trip hazards and therefore, is a prime safety concern. Removing this carpeting has presented many challenges as there is asbestos present underneath the carpet. To remove the asbestos and carpeting requires a large amount of funding, and even though money was set aside to help with the Thrift Shop move, the amount required is much more than currently available. The Thrift Shop Committee has been researching all possible avenues of assistance both via the military and public to assist in this endeavor. Unfortunately, the only assistance we can obtain at this time is through individual donations. In addition, the Committee is in contact with many contractors working to find a solution that the Thrift Shop can afford to create a safe environment for our volunteers and customers. In other news, on December 4th, the Thrift Shop opened its doors for a free day to all. Due to an overwhelming amount of merchandise left after our many sales in November, anyone who had access to our Thrift Shop was invited in to take whatever they could use for no charge. This was well received by our many regular customers and was a nice surprise for our new customers. Many walked away with over a hundred dollars in merchandise, with many items being brand new. This was a fun day of giving back to our community.

In addition, the Thrift Shop has officially moved out of the old location due to scheduled demolition. This move took 3 days and the work of many volunteers. We want to send out a special shout out to our AWESOME thrift shop volunteers, LSC volunteers, InstantHandz volunteers, and the Logistics Readiness Squadron. Without these volunteers our move would not have been possible.

Finally, we are temporarily not accepting donations at this time, including ABUs or other military uniform items. Donations are always greatly appreciated, but we ask that you hold these goods until further notice or donate to another worthy cause. We cannot

begin to set up the Thrift Shop until the carpeting issue is resolved. Therefore, we cannot process and store any goods at this time. Donation collection will resume once the Thrift Shop is established in our new location.

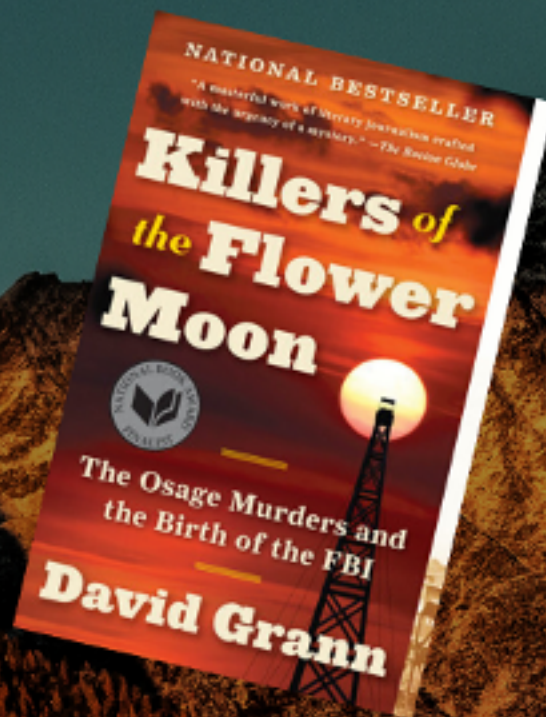
